
D. **Others**

Checklist of Technical and Financial Envelope Requirements for Bidders

1. The Bidder, in submitting the required documents, must use the prescribed forms found in the attached Sample Forms whenever stated. However, should it be unavoidable that a different form will be used, the Bidder must ensure that the substance in the sample forms can be gleaned in the equivalent document/s and duly signed by the authorized representative/issuing entity.
2. During the Eligibility Evaluation, a proposal may still be declared “ineligible” if the contents/substance of the document are found inappropriate or does not comply with the given requirements for this transaction.

First Envelope
Eligibility and Technical documents
a) Eligibility Documents
a.1) Class “A” Document
1. PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership, Platinum Membership
2. Statement Completed Similar Contracts
3. Statement of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contract awarded but not yet started
4. Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) computation in accordance with ITB Clause 5.5
a.2) Class “B” Document
1. If applicable, the Joint Venture Agreement (JVA) in case the joint venture is already in existence, or duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners in accordance with Section 23.1(b) of the IRR
b) Technical Documents
1. Bid security in accordance with ITB Clause 18. If the Bidder opts to submit the bid security in the form of; (1) bank draft/guarantee; (2) a surety bond, it shall be accompanied by a certification by the Insurance Commission that the surety or insurance company is authorized to issue such instruments
2. Conformity with technical specifications, as enumerated and specified in Sections VI and VII of the Bidding Documents; and
3. Sworn statement in accordance with Section 25.3 of the IRR of RA 9184 and using the form prescribed in Section VIII. Bidding Forms.
4. For foreign bidders claiming eligibility by reason of their country’s extension of reciprocal rights to Filipinos, a certification from the relevant government office of their country stating that Filipinos are allowed to participate in their government

procurement activities for the same item or product.

1. Financial Bid Form, which includes bid prices and the applicable Price Schedules, in accordance with ITB Clauses 15.1 and 15.4
2. If the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder, a certification from the DTI issued in accordance with ITB Clause 27, unless otherwise provided in the BDS
